Cancellation and Refund of Taxes Due to Totally Disabled Veteran Status

WHEREAS, the Department of Veterans Affairs has determined Andrew Petrucelli, owner of property at Block 405, Lot 20.07, 359-363 Newton-Swartswood Road, is totally disabled, and the Tax Assessor granted this exemption effective July 5, 2022, and that Mr. Petrucelli is to be exempt from that day forward in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-30:30 et seq.
