ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
BY THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON APPROPRIATING A TOTAL OF \$502,693.00,
INCLUDING A NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL
YEAR 2022 MUNICIPAL AID PROGRAM GRANT FOR PHIL HARDIN ROADSection II, \$129,945.00; AND THE SUM OF \$372,748.00 AVAILABLE IN THE
TOWNSHIP'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHI COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements or purposes of this capital ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Fredon, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey (the "Township") as general improvements. For the improvement or purpose described in this capital ordinance, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$194,165.00 for the Phil Hardin Road – Section II Resurfacing Project, including a NJDOT fiscal year 2022 Municipal Aid Program grant in the amount of \$129,945.00, the sum of \$64,220.00 from the Township's Capital Improvement Fund; \$198,528.00 for the paving of Running Hills Road, Municipal Road and Municipal Parking Lot, from the Township's Capital Improvement Fund; and \$110,000.00 for the purchase of vehicles and equipment for the Department of Public Works from the Township's Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 2. The capital budget of the Township of Fredon is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption in accordance with applicable law.
