## RESOLUTION APPROVING GENERAL FUND TAX LEVY OF THE FREDON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION 2022-2023 BUDGET

**WHEREAS**, on April 19, 2022, the voters of Fredon Township voted down the general fund tax levy proposed by the Fredon Township Board of Education in the amount of \$4,110,270; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 11, 2022, the Fredon Township Committee and Fredon Township Board of Education conducted a special joint meeting to review and discuss the 2022-2023 budget pursuant to, and in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 18A:22-37, <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 6A:23A-9.7, and other laws applicable to the statutory municipal review process; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the position of the Fredon Township Committee that reducing the budget would adversely affecting the Board of Education's ability to provide a thorough and efficient education; and

**WHEREAS**, following their joint meeting, and in furtherance of the foregoing, the Fredon Township Committee and Fredon Township Board of Education approved the general fund tax levy of the Board of Education amounting to \$4,110,270.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fredon Township Committee hereby certifies the budget amount for the 2022-2023 school year for the Fredon Township Board of Education as the original general fund tax levy for the base budget on the ballot defeated by the voters of Fredon Township was \$4,110,270.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Fredon Township Committee that copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Fredon Township Board of Education and Executive County Superintendent of Schools by no later than May 19, 2022.
