

TOWNSHIP OF FREDON
ORDINANCE 2023-03

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RESURFACING OF FREDON-GREENDELL ROAD – SECTION II

BY THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON APPROPRIATING A TOTAL OF \$169,260.00, INCLUDING A NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND FISCAL YEAR 2023 LOCAL AID PROGRAM GRANT FOR FREDON-GREENDELL ROAD – SECTION II, \$155,260.00; AND THE SUM OF \$14,000.00 AVAILABLE IN THE TOWNSHIP’S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR ENGINEERING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements or purposes of this capital ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Fredon, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey (the “Township”) as general improvements. For the improvement or purpose described in this capital ordinance, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$155,260.00 for the Fredon - Greendell – Section II Resurfacing Project, including a NJDOT Trust Fund fiscal year 2023 Local Aid Program grant in the amount of \$155,260.00; and the sum of \$14,000.00 from the Township’s Capital Improvement Fund, for engineering.

Section 2. The capital budget of the Township of Fredon is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption in accordance with applicable law.

CERTIFICATION

TAKE NOTICE that the foregoing ordinance, Ordinance 2023-03, was introduced and approved at first reading at a meeting of the Fredon Township Committee, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, held on March 23, 2023 and that said Capital Ordinance will be further considered for final passage at a meeting of the Township Committee beginning at 7:00 p.m. on April 13, 2023 at the Fredon Municipal Building, 443 Route 94, in the Township of Fredon, at which time and place all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said Capital Ordinance and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Township Clerk’s Office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
