CAPITAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-14

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN PART TO BOND ORDINANCE No. 2023-10 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2023, PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE APPROPRIATION THEREFOR BY \$66,000 FOR A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$266,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A DUMP TRUCK FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the Township of Fredon, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey finally adopted Bond Ordinance No. 2023-10, which included the appropriation of \$200,000 for the purchase of a dump truck for the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the costs for said improvement is higher than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the \$200,000 authorized by Bond Ordinance No. 2023-10 is inadequate and desires to increase such appropriation by \$66,000 to an aggregate amount of \$266,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FREDON, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The additional \$66,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 2. This capital ordinance shall take effect 10 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption.
