All Bulk pickup will be on the date designated below.


Items must be put out the **NIGHT BEFORE** the pick-up date since pick-up begins at **5 AM**.

Interior household bulk items such as stoves, refrigerators, furniture, carpets, etc., but <u>not</u> normal <u>household garbage</u> or <u>bagged garbage</u>. Building material, construction debris, other outdoor items and tires will not be picked up!




