Bulk Pickup is provided for all residential dwellings.

All Bulk pickup will be on the date designated below.

Items must be put out the **NIGHT BEFORE** the pick-up date
since pick-up begins at **5 AM**.

Interior household bulk items such as stoves, refrigerators, furniture, carpets, etc., but not normal household garbage or bagged garbage. Building material, construction debris, other outdoor items and tires will not be picked up!

If it is small enough to fit in a garbage bag or can it is NOT bulk

The following items **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP** for bulk pick-up:

Driver Licenses

The Mobile Units provide the opportunity for drivers to renew their license, obtain a duplicate license, change their name or address on their license, add a boat endorsement, add a veteran designation, register to vote and/or make organ donation selections.

Non-Driver Identification Cards

The Mobile Units can provide residents with photo identification that may then serve as a primary or secondary form of personal ID.

Registrations

Drivers may renew their registration or obtain a duplicate registration card for their vehicle in the Mobile Units.

REAL ID

Mobile units can provide **REAL ID** to a limited number of customers. Customers that have scheduled appointments for **REAL ID**s must arrive no later than 11:30am, the day of appointment.

License Plates

The Mobile Units allow drivers the option to surrender license plates.

Placards

Drivers may obtain a Persons with a Disability, Purple Heart, or Disabled Veteran placard from the Mobile Units.

Examination Permits

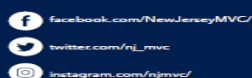
Customers can apply for an examination permit to take a written (law/knowledge) test. However, the written test itself is not available in the Mobile Units.

2024 Recycling Event Schedule



Household Hazardous Waste Days: Saturdays 6/1/24 & 11/2/24

Dispose of oil-based paints, stains, thinners, pool chemicals, mercury, lubricants, chlorine, driveway sealer, fluorescent bulbs, household batteries and more. Limits: 100 lbs. dry waste, 10-gal liquid waste, and 10 fluorescent bulbs **per vehicle free of charge**. Scale charge for larger quantities.



Electronics Recycling Days: Saturdays 4/13/24 & 10/5/24

Free event! Examples: TV's, desktop computers, laptops, desktop printers and fax machines, cell phones, VCR's, DVD's & CD's, copiers, radio & stereos, etc. *(Residents may also drop off some electronics for free during normal business hours. See website for info.)*
