Lead-Based Paint
Paint Thinner/ Gasoline
Rust Remover / Ammonia
Lighter Fluid / Insecticides
Paint Stripper / Varnish
Turpentine / Kerosene
Pesticides / Chlorine
Mercury / Pool Chemicals

Do NOT Bring:

Latex Paint / Motor Oil
Asbestos / PCBs
Picric Acid / Explosives
Prescription Drugs
Electronics / Appliances
Silvex / Medical Waste
Picric Acid / Batteries /
Tires / Smoke Detectors
Empty containers

To dispose of Latex Paint:

*Pour excess into another can until ¾ full
*Add clay-based kitty litter or speedy dry
*Allow mixture to dry
*Dispose of with household trash
