Interior household bulk items such as stoves, refrigerators, furniture, carpets, etc., but **not** normal **household garbage or bagged garbage**. Building material, construction debris, other outdoor items and tires will not be picked up!

The Keepers of Coursen's Corners invite the public to stop by their upcoming Open House set for Sunday, Oct 15, 2023 from 12-4 PM located in Fredon, NJ. History of the house and family goes back to the American Revolution, as the influence of the original Coursen settlers and their descendants contributed greatly to local life throughout New Jersey and broadened to parts of the country over the decades. It's a step back in time as the Keepers welcome all who are interested in genealogy and in seeing a living history example of the homestead. Restored different rooms span years from 1805 when the Old Kitchen and Hearth was the hub of the home, through Civil War and Victorian eras, and the early 20th century. Original artifacts, many period photographs of Who's Who, and heirlooms of the family are displayed as one walks through. All convey the sense of presence and spirit far better than online virtual representations. Come see for yourself and get involved in preserving this under-appreciated gem in Sussex County!
