History of the house and family goes back to the American Revolution, as the influence of the original Coursen settlers and their descendants contributed greatly to local life throughout New Jersey and broadened to parts of the country over the decades. It's a step back in time as the Keepers welcome all who are interested in genealogy and in seeing a living history example of the homestead.
