

**TOWNSHIP OF FREDON**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03**

**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN PART TO BOND ORDINANCE NO. 2023-10 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2023, PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE APPROPRIATION THEREFOR BY \$43,874.00 FOR A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$343,874.00 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN AMBULANCE FOR THE FREDON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY/EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Township of Fredon, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, adopted Bond Ordinance No. 2023-10, which included the appropriation of \$300,000.00 for the acquisition of an ambulance for the Fredon Township Volunteer Fire Company/Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the costs for said improvement is higher than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the \$300,000.00 authorized by Bond Ordinance No. 2023-10 is inadequate and desires to increase such appropriation by \$43,874.00 to an aggregate amount of \$343,874.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Fredon, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) as follows:

Section 1. The additional \$43,874.00 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve for Fire Apparatus.

Section 2. This capital ordinance shall take effect 10 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption.
