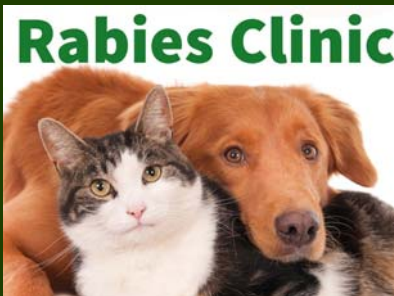
Rabies Clinic

December 1, 2018 10AM -12noon

A free Rabies Clinic will be held on Saturday, December 1st at the Fredon Township Municipal Garage, 443 Route

94, from 10:00 A.M. until 12:00 P.M. All dogs must be leashed

(**No retractable leashes.**) and cats must be in carriers or confined. Both cats and dogs must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Per New Jersey State Law, all dogs and cats must be vaccinated against rabies. The next rabies clinic held in Fredon Township will be in the Spring of 2019. 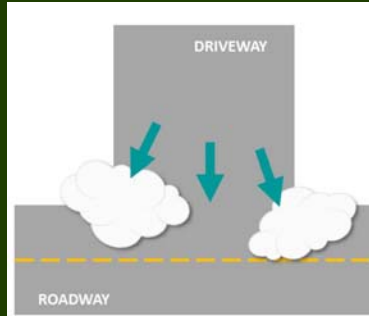

Winter Reminders

from the Department of Public Works

One never knows what the winter will bring as far as the amount of snowfall, so please keep in mind that Fredon Township Ordinances state that **"no snow which accumulates within private property is to be thrown, placed or deposited upon the sidewalks, streets or public roads of the Township"**. Additionally, please make sure that any private contractor plowing your driveway complies with this ordinance, as it is the property owners' responsibility. Snow plowed, blown or shoveled onto the roadway often creates an unexpected hazard for drivers. Noncompliance with this ordinance may result in a notice of violation and fines beginning at \$100.00.



**No parking on any street 24/7
from November 1 to April 15th**

Residents are reminded that parking on any street at any time from November 1st through April 15th is prohibited in order to facilitate snow removal.



Recycling pick-up takes place on the **first** and **third** Monday of each month. Please place recyclables out for the scheduled day regardless of any holidays. 2019 Dog Licenses are due by January 31, 2019. Licenses received after January 31st are subject to a

\$5.00 per month, per dog, late fee. Please click on the dog license application link, which includes additional information.

The rabies shot must be current through **November 1st of the current licensing year.** If your dog's vaccination expires before November 1st of this year (2019), you must have your dog re-vaccinated before submitting this application. The owner is required to supply proof of vaccination from the veterinarian. Click for a list other rabies clinics in Sussex County.


