Rabies Clinic - December 1, 2018

A free Rabies Clinic will be held on Saturday, December 1st at the Fredon Township Municipal Garage, 443 Route 94, from 10:00 A.M. until 12:00 P.M. All dogs must be leashed (***No retractable leashes.***) and cats must be in carriers or confined. Both cats and dogs must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Per New Jersey State Law, all dogs and cats must be vaccinated against rabies. The next rabies clinic held in Fredon Township will be in the Spring of 2019. If you have any questions,
