**RESOLUTION TO CANCEL AND REFUND TAXES DUE TO VETERAN'S  
EXEMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana Salcedo, widow of Frederick Salcedo, owns the property located at 13 Troon Drive know as Block 1805 Lot 1 Qualification C0003 and recorded in deed dated May 30, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, Frederick Salcedo was a 100% disabled Veteran; and

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Salcedo has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentation proofs required to the Tax Assessor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective July 16, 2020


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of Fredon Township hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 1805 Lot 1 Qualification C0003 effective July 16, 2020 and thereafter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2020 taxes in the amount of \$2,199.00 and issue a refund to Mrs. Salcedo in the proration amount of \$2,044.35 representing the overpayment created by granting the veteran exemption.

3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Taxes Due = \$2,442.49/92 Days = \$26.55 Per Day  
\$26.55 x 77 Days = \$2,044.35 Refund Due
