Resolution to Cancel Taxes Due to Veteran Exemption

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

WHEREAS, Ricardo Arias-Vasquez, owns the property located at 32 Puder Road known as Block 2003 Lot 4.04 and recorded in deed dated May 9, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Ricardo Arias-Vasquez is a 100% disabled Veteran; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Arias-Vasquez has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentation proof required to the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective July 1, 2021

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Committee of Fredon Township hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 2003 Lot 4.04 effective July 1, 2021 and thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel 3rd and 4th quarter 2021 taxes in the amount of \$4,223.33.
