

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 75

### Resolution to Cancel & Refund Taxes Due to Veteran Exemption

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

**WHEREAS**, David Pereda, owns the property located at 303 Hillside Terrace know as Block 2009 Lot 2 and recorded in deed dated October 20, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, David Pereda is a 100% disabled Veteran; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Pereda has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentation proofs required to the Tax Assessor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective October 20, 2021

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of Fredon Township hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 2009 Lot 2 effective October 20, 2021 and thereafter.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to issue a refund to Corelogic in the proration amount of \$2,147.66 representing the overpayment created by granting the veteran exemption.
